

DO YOU HAVE PARKINSON'S DISEASE AND ARE YOU INTERESTED IN TELLING US ABOUT YOUR SWALLOWING OR VOICE DIFFICULTY?

You may be eligible for the Knowledge of Swallowing and Voice Difficulty in Parkinson's disease study that aims to examine patient-centered knowledge regarding their experiences with swallowing and/or voice difficulty. - You are diagnosed with idiopathic (or sporadic/typical) Parkinson's disease
- You are over the age of 50.

WHAT IS INVOLVED IF I PARTICIPATE?

- Participants will be asked to take a survey focused on their knowledge or experience with swallowing and voice difficulty.
- This is a one-time survey that will take approximately 60 minutes.
- You will need access to a phone/computer.
